Contingency Planning – Important information

As a school offering external examinations, we adhere to the regulations of the Joint Council for Qualifications. I therefore need to make you aware that all candidates must remain available until

Wednesday 26 June 2019,

should an awarding body need to invoke its contingency plan.

Please see the information below, taken from the 2018/19 JCQ Instructions for Conducting Examinations.

The qualification regulators, JCQ and government departments responsible for education have prepared and agreed information for schools and colleges in the event of examinations being seriously disrupted. This jointly agreed information will ensure consistency of response in the event of major disruption to the examinations system affecting significant numbers of candidates.
