Dear Parent / Carer,

As part of Hans Price Academy on-going commitment to supporting Year 11 with their exams, I am extremely pleased to be able to offer all Year 11s a place at our 'Night Club' starting this Thursday. Last year was the first time Hans Price offered Night Club and it definitely made a difference for students.

Night club is designed to be a space which allows students to independently revise, either in small groups or individually, giving them access to resources and support they might not have at home. Night Club has resources such as past papers, exam specific materials, blank flash cards or A3 paper to make mind maps. It is a very positive work space for students and runs from 4pm to 5.30pm.

Currently Night Club is not mandatory for students, it is however strongly recommended. The more revision students do early on, the less stressful they will find Year 11 and the more successful they will be in their exams. I would strongly recommend Night Club to students that might find it difficult to concentrate revising at home or struggle to know where to start. A member of senior management is always present in the room to support students. Last year parents did say they felt it removed some of their concerns and conflict over revision with their child as when students returned home at the end of the day, they knew a session of good, meaningful revision had been completed at Night Club.

As attendance in currently voluntary we are rewarding students who do attend with a snack and achievement points for their College towards the College Cup. There has already been some interest from Year 11s to offering another night for Night Club and if there is enough uptake we will organise this.
